2. Draft June 18 GSP Coordination Committee Meeting Notes

- The draft notes from the June 18 GSP Coordination Committee meeting were included in the meeting packet. The GSA representatives were requested to review and provide edits/comments, as necessary.

3. Public Outreach

- The presentation slides for the Tuesday, July 21 workshop were included in the meeting packet. Feedback on the slides was requested from the GSA representatives by close of business Friday, July 17. Registration for the workshop webinar is required. The GSA representatives were encouraged to register ASAP, if they had not done so already, so that they have access to the webinar.
- Workshop registration is low. Kirsten Pringle, Stantec, encouraged the GSA representatives to reach out to their constituents or customers to help promote the workshop.
- Michael Callahan, San Joaquin County, and Ms. Pringle have reached out to some regional stakeholder organizations, including the San Joaquin County Farm Bureau Federation, Mountain House Community Services District, and Stockton East Water District, regarding the upcoming workshop.

- The GSA representatives are to send the names and contact information for their designated outreach contact to Kirsten Pringle and Michael Callahan.

4. GSP Preparation Status

- The first three GSP chapters are available for review. A draft of Chapter 4 is in the final stages of revisions. Mr. Callahan encouraged the other GSA representatives to provide comments on Chapter 4, if they had not done so already, ASAP.
- A draft of Chapter 5 is set to be released next week, but due to scheduling this may be delayed one week.
- Mr. Callahan shared that Tyler Hatch, California Department of Water Resources, has stated that the C2VSIM fine grid model (version 1) will be available by the end of this month. Once available, the model will be used to help develop Chapter 6.
- Work on Chapter 8 has been initiated.

5. Adjacent Subbasin Updates

- The East Contra Costa Subbasin GSAs held their first workshop on July 9 and covered topics similar to what will be covered at the Tracy Subbasin workshop next week. There were 20 participants. Questions from the audience included topics such as subsidence, groundwater monitoring, sea level rise, water budget, and the subbasin governance structure. To advertise for their workshop, the East Contra Costa Subbasin GSAs placed an ad in a newspaper and did direct outreach to stakeholders.
- The Eastern San Joaquin Subbasin is seeking a grant to update to the data management system and GIS.
